SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING CALLED FOR BROOKSWOOD-FERNRIDGE COMMUNITY PLAN UPDATE

The proposed update to the Brookswood-Fernridge Community Plan will be brought back to Township of Langley Council at a special public meeting to be held Monday, July 17, at 9:00am, in the Civic Facility's Fraser River Presentation Theatre.

As there were several amendments made to the draft 2017 Plan, Mayor Jack Froese has asked that staff provide a presentation on the amendments and their effect on the 2017 Plan.

He has also asked for a staff presentation comparing the proposed 2017 Community Plan, as amended, with the current 1987 Community Plan.

"Council appreciates all the public input that has been received over the past several months and has reviewed vast amounts of information in preparation for and during the two-day Council meetings held this week," Froese said. "I want to be sure that a decision that will impact the community for generations to come is made with fresh eyes and minds, and that all implications are considered in this complex matter."

"It is in everyone's best interest to take a second look at such a significant plan," Froese said.

Froese called for third reading of Bylaw 5300, which amends the Langley Official Community Plan to provide an updated Community Plan for Brookswood-Fernridge, to be brought back for reconsideration.
